Assembly Bill (AB) 459, effective July 1, 2021, and passed during the 81<sup>st</sup> Regular Session of the Nevada Legislature (2021), amends certain provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) section 610 and transfers the responsibility and accountability for the Nevada State Apprenticeship Council (NSAC), State Apprenticeship Director, and registered apprenticeship programs in the State of Nevada to the Office of the Labor Commissioner (OLC). Section 10.5 of AB 459 states: 1. The Office of the Labor Commissioner shall act as the State Apprenticeship Agency as defined in 29 C.F.R. § 29.2 and has responsibility and accountability for apprenticeship in this State. Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) section 610 sets forth additional regulations for the NSAC, State Apprenticeship Director, and registered apprenticeship programs.

While conducting a review of Nevada's registered apprenticeship programs now under the oversight of the OLC, we have found that your program, Alamo Power District #3 - NV001940002, currently shows zero registered apprentices. This is a potential violation of NAC section 610.365. The NSAC has authority to cancel an approved program and/or an occupation within an approved program if the requirements of NAC section 610.365 are not met. Please see NAC section 610.365 below.

While this is true, we feel the obligation to inform this council that because of our staffing size needs and the location of our service territory, we will always find it very difficult to meet the NAC requirements of having a new registered apprenticeship every year. Because of the dynamics of limited staff and long-term employees there is usually no need for new hires but maybe once every 10 years. For this reason, we will voluntarily cancel our program. We would ask consideration when we make a request to reinstate our program when the need arises to add an apprentice in the future.
